Ordinance No. O:26-07

An Ordinance Appropriating The Sum Of Not More Than \$34,000.00 From The Capital Improvement Fund Of The General Capital Account In Connection With Direct Install Upgrades for the Municipal Building HVAC

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE:

This Ordinance is intended to appropriate the sum of up to \$34,000.00 from the Capital Improvement Fund of the General Capital Account in conjunction with the costs attributable to HVAC upgrades in the Township Municipal Building to become more energy efficient through the NJ Direct Install program initiated by Jersey Central Power and Light Company and administered through Ameritech Energy Corporation;

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Harmony, County of Warren and State of New Jersey that:

1. There are funds available in the Capital Improvement Fund of the General Capital Account in the Municipal Budget of the Township of Harmony for costs attributable to the items listed in the Statement of Purpose.

The costs are associated with energy efficient upgrades through the Direct Install Program;

2. There is hereby appropriated the sum of up to \$34,000.00 from the Capital Improvement Fund of the General Capital Account in the Municipal Budget of the Township of Harmony for the aforementioned purposes.
3. There is no debt authorized by this Ordinance.
4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage following a public hearing to be conducted thereon and publication of notice of final passage with the requirements of law.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the foregoing Ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading by the Harmony Township Committee as its budget meeting held on May 7, 2026, which Ordinance shall be given further consideration for final passage following a public hearing to be conducted thereon, at its regular monthly meeting to be held on June 2, 2026, which shall commence at 6:00 p.m. at the Harmony Township Municipal Building, 3003 Belvidere Road, Phillipsburg, New Jersey.
